- \* Estimate of check to Oversight committee, around \$2000
- \* 120 went to the Kern County Museum
- \* 98 attended the ladies luncheon
- \* 44 attended cooking class
- \* 11 bowlers
- \* 40 golfers
- \* 175 attended Buck Owens
- \* 10 vendors
- \* We gave away \$750 at Bingo, and \$1400 in gift card to Flying J and Camping World not counting donations from vendors

I hope my banking skills are okay and we do have a \$2000 check coming back to the oversight committee. As you could see we could have reduced gift cards and not had bingo and the rally could have returned all 3300 dollars it received from the owners club. Charging a little more on the registration form could easy covered all up front monies. Hopes this helps a little and informs a lot.
